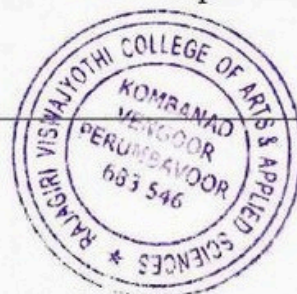

Detailed Report

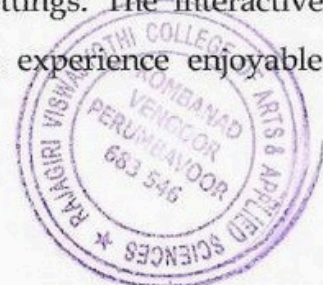

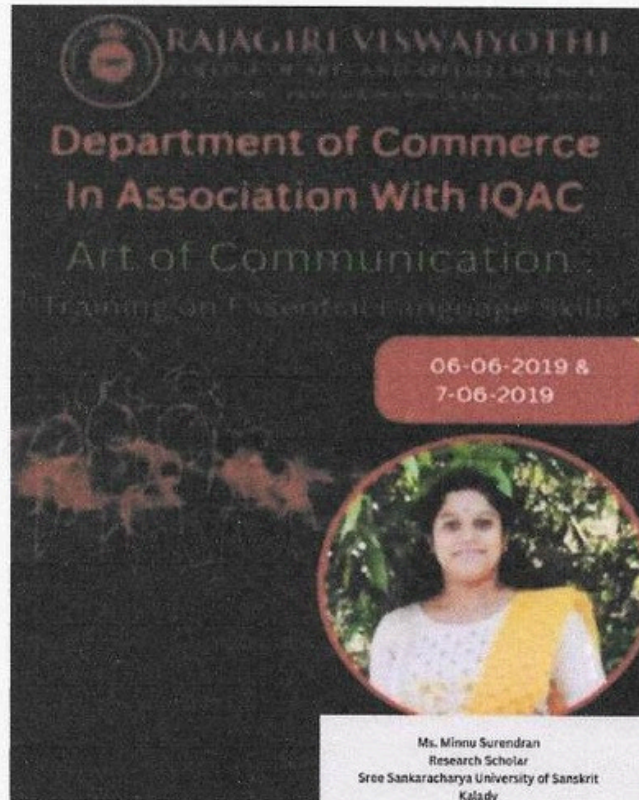

Poster of Art of Communication: Training Programme on Essential Language Skills


